## Safety

## What is Full Bore?

Full bore is a sport of long range target shooting. It includes two main disciplines; F-Class and Target Rifle. F-Class involves the use of a scoped rifle supported by a bipod or rest. In Target Rifle peep sights are used and the rifle is supported by the shooter and a sling. Both disciplines are fired from the prone position (lying down). The sport embraces age and gender equity; everyone competes together. Matches follow the Standard Shooting Rules of the NRAA. The standard calibre of firearms used are 7.62mm (.308 Winchester) or 5.56mm (.223 Remington).

With IDRC you will have the opportunity to be as competitive as you want to be. From the casual comer to the serious contender there is something for everyone.
