### You should always treat every firearm as if it is loaded.

#### Your firearm is your responsibility.







#### You should always ensure your firing zone is clear and identify your target beyond all doubt.







### It is OK to point a firearm at or near another person.







#### A firearm should be loaded at all times.







# You shouldn't keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to fire.







#### When you are finished shooting you should remove magazine and ammunition then check the chamber is empty







#### You should make sure your firearms are transported securely to prevent misuse or theft.







### Its not Ok to let anyone use your firearms anytime they like.







#### You should encourage safe and responsible handling of firearms in the field, on the range and within the community.







### It's a good idea to mix shooting with drugs or alcohol.





# You shouldn't worry about maintaining firearms or checking the ammunition is correct.







#### You should always store firearms in the same locked container as the ammunition for them when not in use.








#### You should be familiar with the legal requirements of safe storage and ownership of firearms, their possession and use in the state or territory you visit.
